Lineman Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior or graduate of one of the following high schools: Glasgow, Hinsdale, Lustre, Nashua, Opheim, Scobey, Frazer, or Wolf Point.
- 2. The candidate's parents or guardians must be a member of NorVal Electric Cooperative and come from the service territory.
- 3. The applicant must include a letter of recommendation, from the current school would be preferrable.
- 4. The applicant must carry a 2.5 minimum grade point average.
- 5. The applicant must include a personal statement. This statement should include information about their future goals, as well as previous school and community activities including volunteer work.
- 6. Please attach required items to your application.
- 7. The final candidate must go through an interview process with the education committee for final acceptance into this program.
- 8. The final candidate will attend a school that specializes in lineman training.
- 9. Applications are due in the office <u>6 months</u> before prior to the start of your program.

Note: These funds must be used toward furthering your education by attending an institution of higher learning. Funds will be dispersed as students starts next semester and only to the school. Funds will be dispersed in accordance to the school's preference, and written to the school. These monies will cover tuition, tools, books and associated fees, thus being on these expenses.
